
GOFER

The GOFER project idea is to develop concepts for control and management of heavy freight vehicles in urban areas, much the same way as the air control manages airplanes.



- The Norwegian Research Council sponsors the project, involving national and local road authorities, municipalities, terminal- and freight operators, as well as R&D-organisations in Norway.
- The GOFER project period is 2009 to mid 2012.
- Two live demonstrators, involving road-rail-terminals in the Norwegian cities of Oslo and Trondheim, are scheduled for 2011.
- The functionality to be included in the GOFER demonstrators is yet to be decided, but one idea is to focus on moving the queue of heavy freight vehicles away from the terminal area, to more suitable waiting and resting areas at the main entrances to the city.
